Davis is currently on the adjunct faculty at SUNY Fredonia and has also served as cooperating teacher for the college's student teachers for the past four years. In addition, Davis passionately advocates music education in holding the position of *Public Relations Chair* for the *Erie County Music Educator's Association*. In 2007 Davis chaired the *New York State School Music Association Area-All State Festival's* jazz band, working with guest conductor Rich Thompson.
